Abstract

Lean has been applied by financial services companies for several years, but most of these efforts fail to achieve the full potential, often because interlinked challenges are addressed separately. However, if implemented the right way, lean can simultaneously address all three issues of service, cost and staff engagement, producing up to 30 percent reductions in cost while increasing customer satisfaction and staff engagement. This short paper aims to illustrate how these results can be achieved sustainably.


